4. FIRST AID MEASURES

General Advice : Seek medical advice immediately and show this safety data sheet. Take off all contaminated clothing.

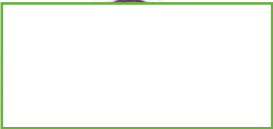
