1. About This Manual

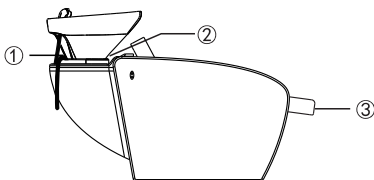

- When adjusting each part, please keep your hands, feet and head away from the position indicated by the arrow. (As shown in the photo)



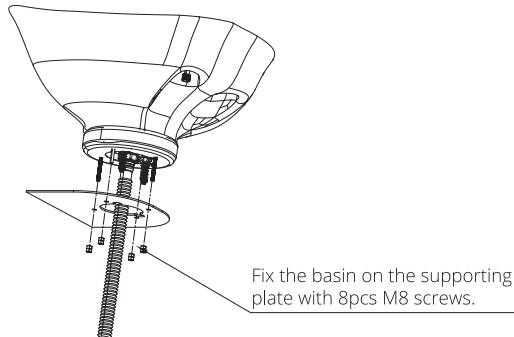
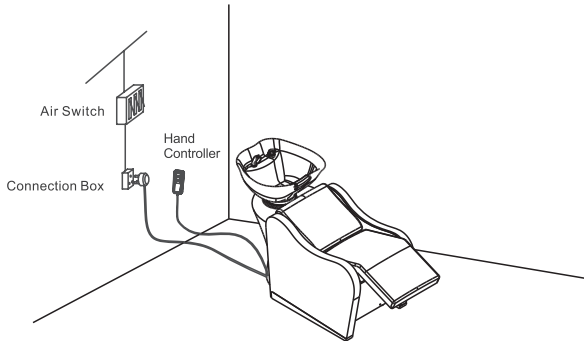
4. Caution

5. Installation

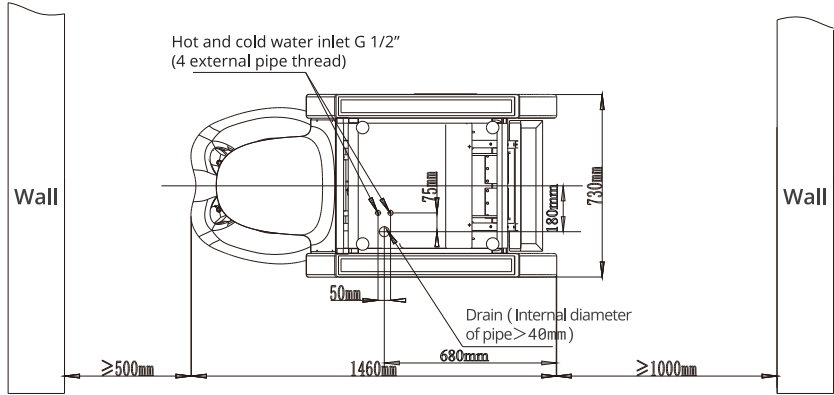
1. Put the product to a proper location, according to the overall layout, the daylighting or artificial lightings and operation condition of the salon's or the home. And keep it in the clean, dry and cool environment.
2. Open the packing carton to check if the product is intact and whether the accessories or spares are complete. Please contact distributor or us if there's any problem.
3. Installation

Place the product to the proper position. Please note that it is unnecessary to install extra screw on the floor to fasten the bed, because the original design has taken the stability into consideration. But please ensure the product is placed on a firm and flat ground, so as to prevent any accident.

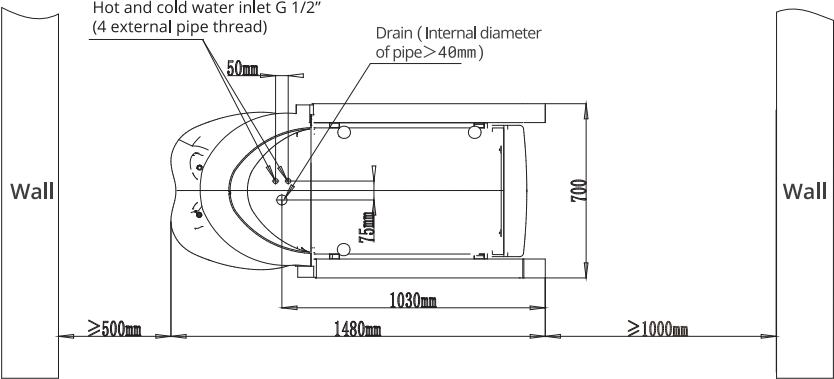


4、Installation Diagram

Daylesford Basin Unit



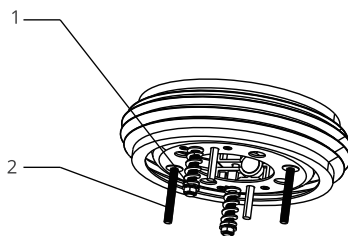

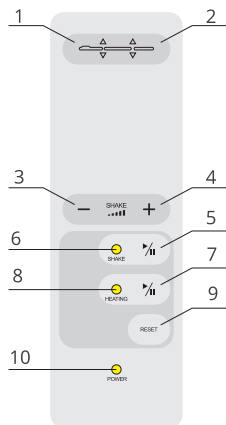
7. Operation

● Instruction of tilting ceramic basin

Tilt ceramic basin to appropriate angle according to client's request. See figure. Adjust part 1 to tighten or loosen the basin. Adjust part 2 to tilt the basin.



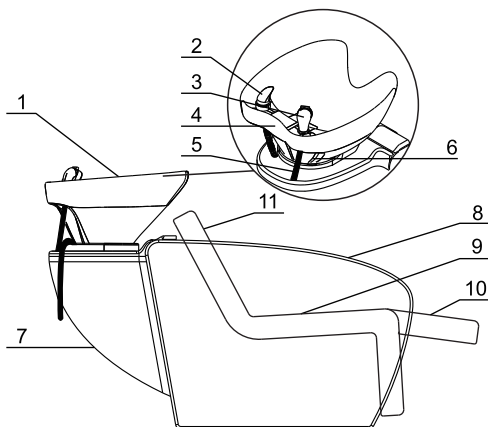
● Instruction of hand control and operation



NO.	Hand control	Operation
1	Up	The chair moves up by pressing this button.
2	Down	The chair moves down by pressing this button.
3	Massage weaken	Massage will weaken by pressing the button. There are maximum five gears adjustment.
4	Massage strengthen	Massage will strengthen by pressing the button. There are maximum five gears adjustment.
5	Button of massage	The indicator light is on after pressing the button to start the massage. The indicator light is off to finish the mode after pressing the button again.
6	Indicator light of massage	
7	Button of heating	The indicator light is on after pressing the button. It's heating up.
8	Indicator light of heating	
9	Reset	The chair automatically moves to a sitting position by pressing the button.
10	Power indicator	Under normal power supply: 1) control box and hand control in correct connection: indicator light is on 2) control box or hand control in incorrect connection: indicator light is off

Notes: The heating function is only available for the model with heating function

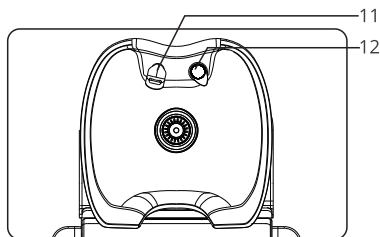

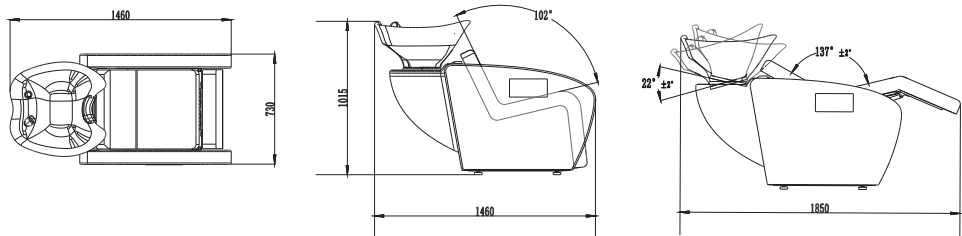
Pipes, valve and hand control mentioned above are standard configuration. If there is any requirement, please contact dealer or manufacturer.

12	Water temperature and yield	Pointer to left/right for switching warm/cold water supply.Pointer to up/down for adjusting water yield.

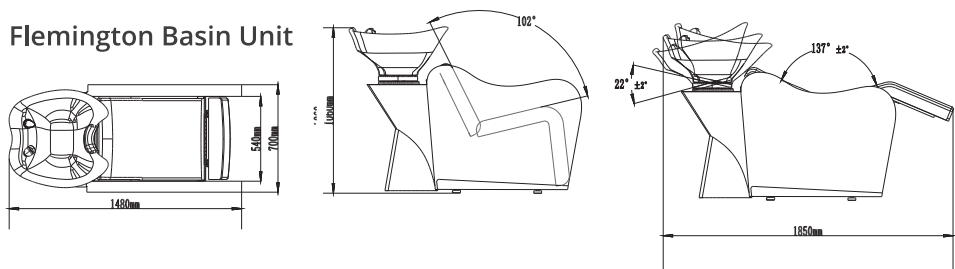


After each operation or when the wash unit is not in use, please ensure seat be back to lowest position. Press button of "RESET" if wash unit is not in seating position.

Daylesford Basin Unit



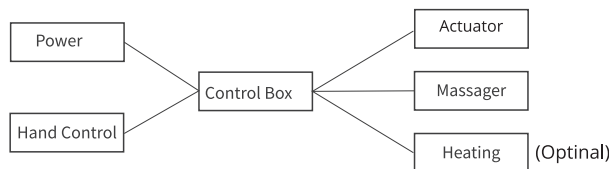

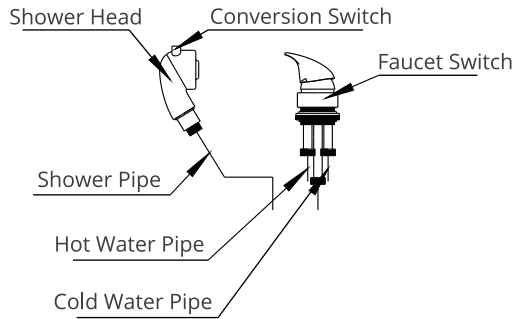

9. Electric Circuit



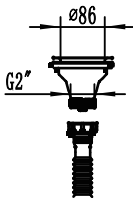
10. Principle of water channel

- The water connection principle of shampoo basin is as follows.

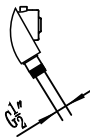

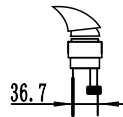

12. Maintenance

13. Troubleshooting

The Fault Phenomenon	Reason	Solution
Do not work when press button	1. At the maximum position	Press another button
	2. Do not plug in or well connect with power supply.	Unplug and re-plug with power supply
	3. Connectors got loose	Reconnect the connector
Abnormal noise or shaking problem	Screws or bolts got loose	Tighten the screws or bolts

If problem is still not solved after above operations, please contact maintenance center or supplier to solve it.

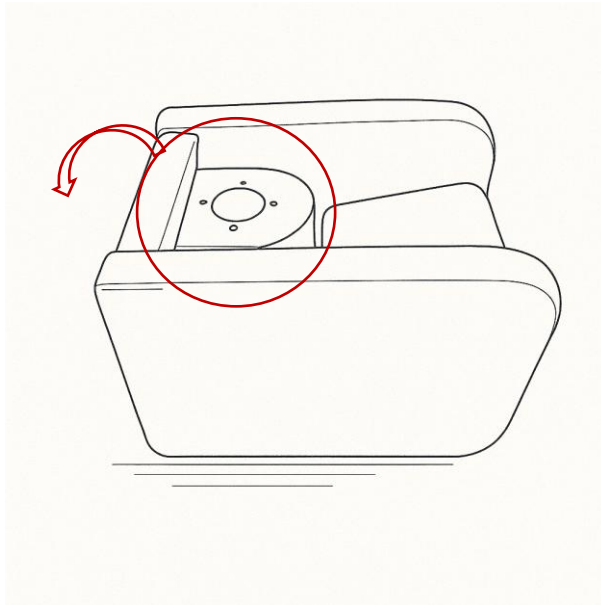

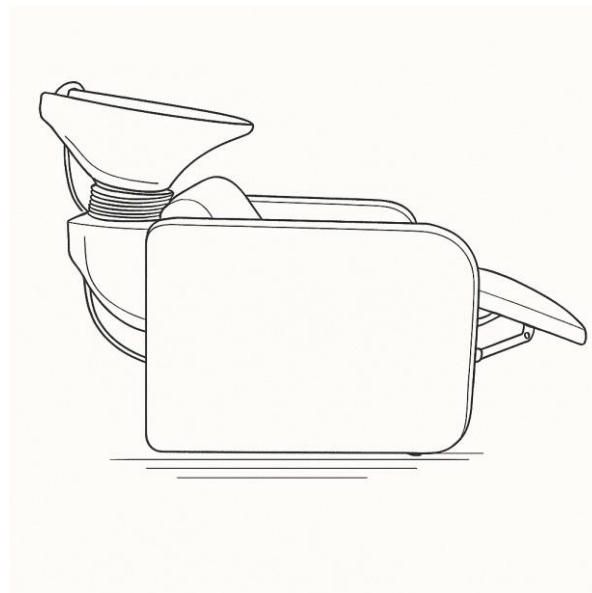
Step 1: Remove the chair from the carton. It will look like this when you take out of the carton:



Step 2: Remove the pedestal from within chair (pedestal circled in image on the left), by unscrewing the screws holding pedestal in place.

Step 3: Take the pedestal out and screw onto the back of the chair on the outside. It should look the image below. (There are separate screws to secure the pedestal in a bag inside the carton)

Note: Electric Basin Unit comes with a chrome pedestal and manual basin unit comes with black pedestal



Step 4: With the help of a certified plumber, install the plumbing and basin, they should not require further information.

Step 3: Place back cushion into place and the chair is complete.
